

Sports Premium

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to schools. The funding amount received by schools is based upon the number of children of primary age at the school. The Sport Premium must be used to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increase participation in PE & Sport.

From September 2015 – July 2016 PE and Sport Grant allocation will be £3,689. This money will be spent on improving the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of pupils so that they develop healthy lifestyles.

- £1000 will be for new equipment for the West Wing Hall
- £750 will be allocated for good quality equipment for main sports hall
- £500 will be allocated to purchase training and resources for the new P.E scheme Real P.E

At Crossley Hall Primary PE and sport are highly valued. We encourage all children to participate in good quality lessons, various competitions clubs and active break and lunch times.

- External coaches are used to deliver clubs and develop staff expertise in specialist areas.
- Links are strong with a local secondary school that organises competitions against other primary schools
- Extra sports activities will be available to all pupils as part of the exceed partnership
- Extra and additional activities such as climbing, caving and orienteering are provided on residential visits with specialist instruction.

Active break times

Pupils are being trained to be sports leaders at playtimes. This will support children to be more active at break times and participate in team games and teach good sportsmanship. Children learning to hula hoop and skip will be a main focus
